- **It can have long term effects on participation in social activities, reducing mental burden during conversations, and improving overall quality of life.**

Who provides AR?

- **Audiologist:** Learning about how hearing loss affects you, is the first step they need to ensure they can help you.
- **Speech Language Pathologist (SLP):** The specialty of an SLP will enhance.
- speech and language communication, when applicable.
- **Online:** You can choose to take online courses to compliment your AR training
